

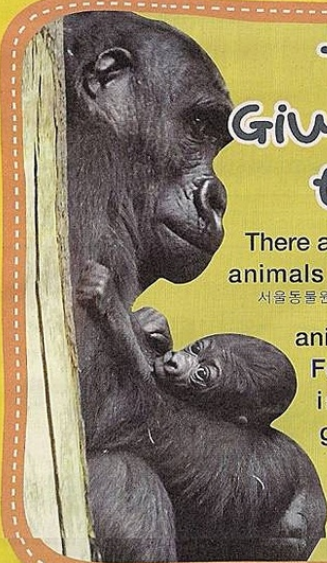






the yellow dust often covers China. It is a serious problem in the country. It is very bad for people's health.

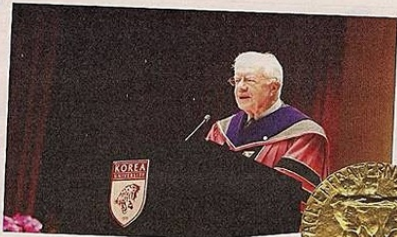

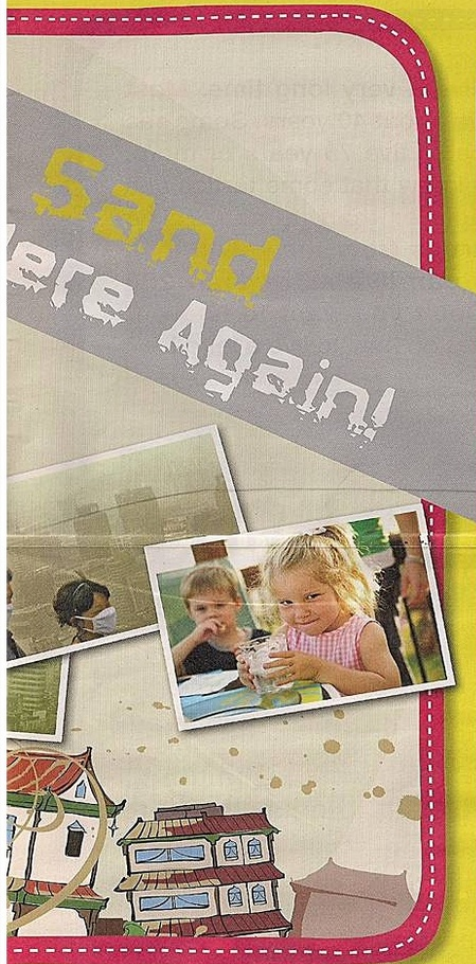
Yellow Season Is A


