# Robots Teach English to Kids

Have you ever wanted to have a robot friend? In many movies and feature animations, robots are good friends to kids. Soon it will no longer just be a story on the screens. Within 5 years, children will be able to study with friendly robot English teachers! At a robotics conference held in Seoul in late January, many scientists and experts announced that English-speaking robots will replace native speakers as teachers in the near future. "By 2015, robots will be able to help teachers in English classrooms. And by

2018, it will be possible for the robots to teach English themselves without help," said an economist at Hyundai Research Institute (현대경제연구원). Currently, some schools in Masan are already using English-speaking robots during classes. Students like the robot teachers very much. They often play English games with the robots even after the class is over. Soon, more robots will help children learn English in more fun ways! ✎

## Super Earth



Recently, American astronomers found a new planet that is similar in size to the Earth. It is close to our planet – only about 40 light years away. The planet is called GJ 1214b. It is 2.7 times larger than the Earth. Scientists classified it as a super Earth. A super Earth is an extra-solar planet with a mass between that of the Earth and the Solar System's gas giants. The newly found planet orbits a star much smaller and less brighter than our sun. To our surprise, it is rich in water! "However, the newly found planet has too thick an atmosphere and is too hot. Maybe it's unlikely that any life on the super

Earth would be similar to life on our planet," said David Charbonneau, a Harvard professor of astronomy. He wrote an article about the discovery, which was published last week in the journal *Nature*. "But the discovery is very meaningful because we have found a watery world orbiting a very nearby and very small star." For many years, astronomers believed that planets only orbited stars that were similar in size to the sun. "Nature is just far more inventive in making planets than we were imagining," he added. There is so much to discover in the universe. ✽

## Mountain in China Renamed After Avatar

Did you watch the movie *Avatar*? It is a Sci-fi movie about a fictional planet called Pandora. Many people all over the world have watched it. As of last week, it became the most successful film in history! More than 10 million people watched this movie in Korea alone. The movie is so popular that a mountain in China even got a new name after the mountain in *Avatar*!




In the movie, there are floating mountains called Hallelujah. The mountains look very similar to a mountain in Hunan province, central China. Its original name was "South Sky Pillar." But the city government renamed it "Avatar Hallelujah Mountain" on January 25.

The city government said on its website that the Avatar Hallelujah Mountain was believed to have inspired the floating mountains set on Pandora, which is one of the most dramatic images in the movie. "A Hollywood photographer came to our province in December, 2008 and shot a number of photos that were used by the film's artists," it said.



Avatar is also a big hit in China. It was released in both 2D and 3D versions on January 4. It has become China's all-time box-office champion, attracting countless people to theaters. The city expects the mountain's similarity to the film version to draw many tourists to the province. The beautiful mountain was designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1992.



## Run for Your Brain!

Many people go jogging in the morning for their health. Yes, jogging makes your body stronger and healthier. But there is one more good reason for you to start running. Researchers reported that running is also good for your brain!






According to a new Cambridge University study, running can help improve your brain power. It also helps boost your memory. The British researchers found that running a few days a week will help in the growth of a great number of new brain cells.

The researchers studied two groups of mice. The first group ran 24 kilometers every day for a week, while the second group didn't run at all. According to the researchers, the first group showed improved mental ability. The running mice scored nearly twice as high than the other group on a memory test after the week of running.

"We found that exercise can actually help make the brain healthy and work better. To improve our brain power, we should run a few days a week," said Timothy Bussey, a scientist at Cambridge who led the study.

"Our conclusion is, running improves the ability to recall memories, a skill that is essential for learning," he added. The study was published in the Proceedings of the National Academy of Sciences.

If you want to make your brain more powerful and improve your memory, start running!

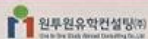
