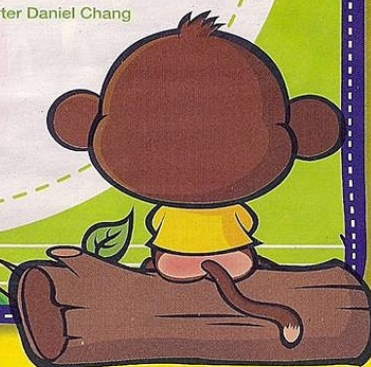
Which Is the Smallest Monkey in the World?

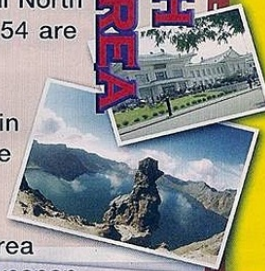

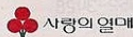
