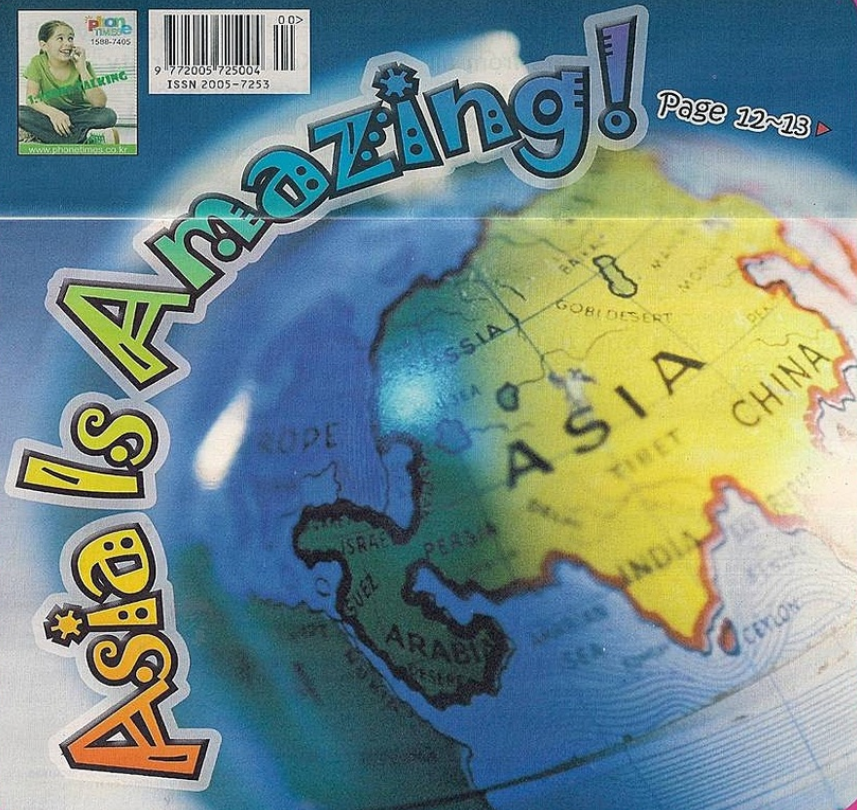

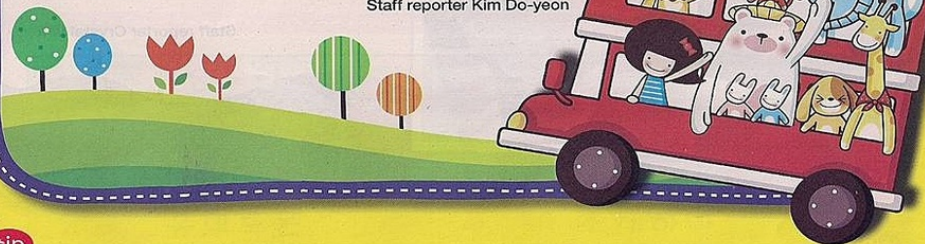


London's New Double-Decker

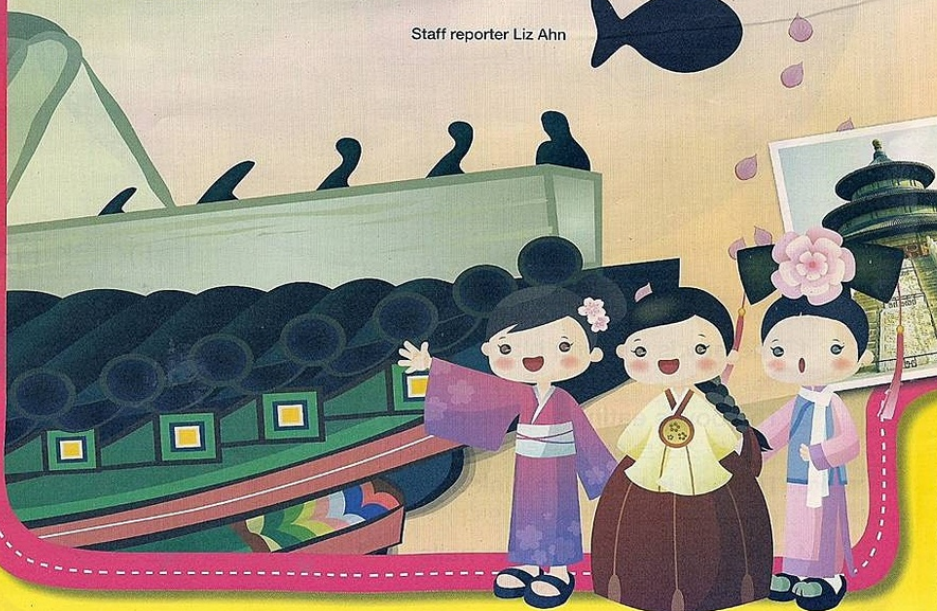

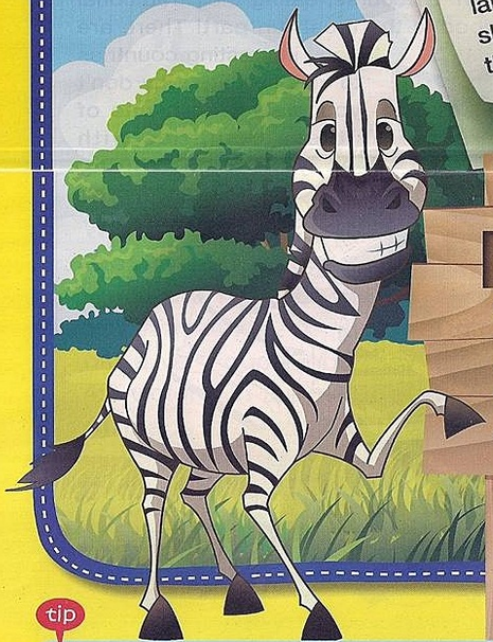

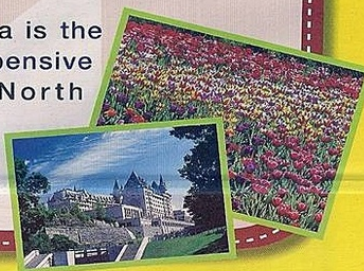
