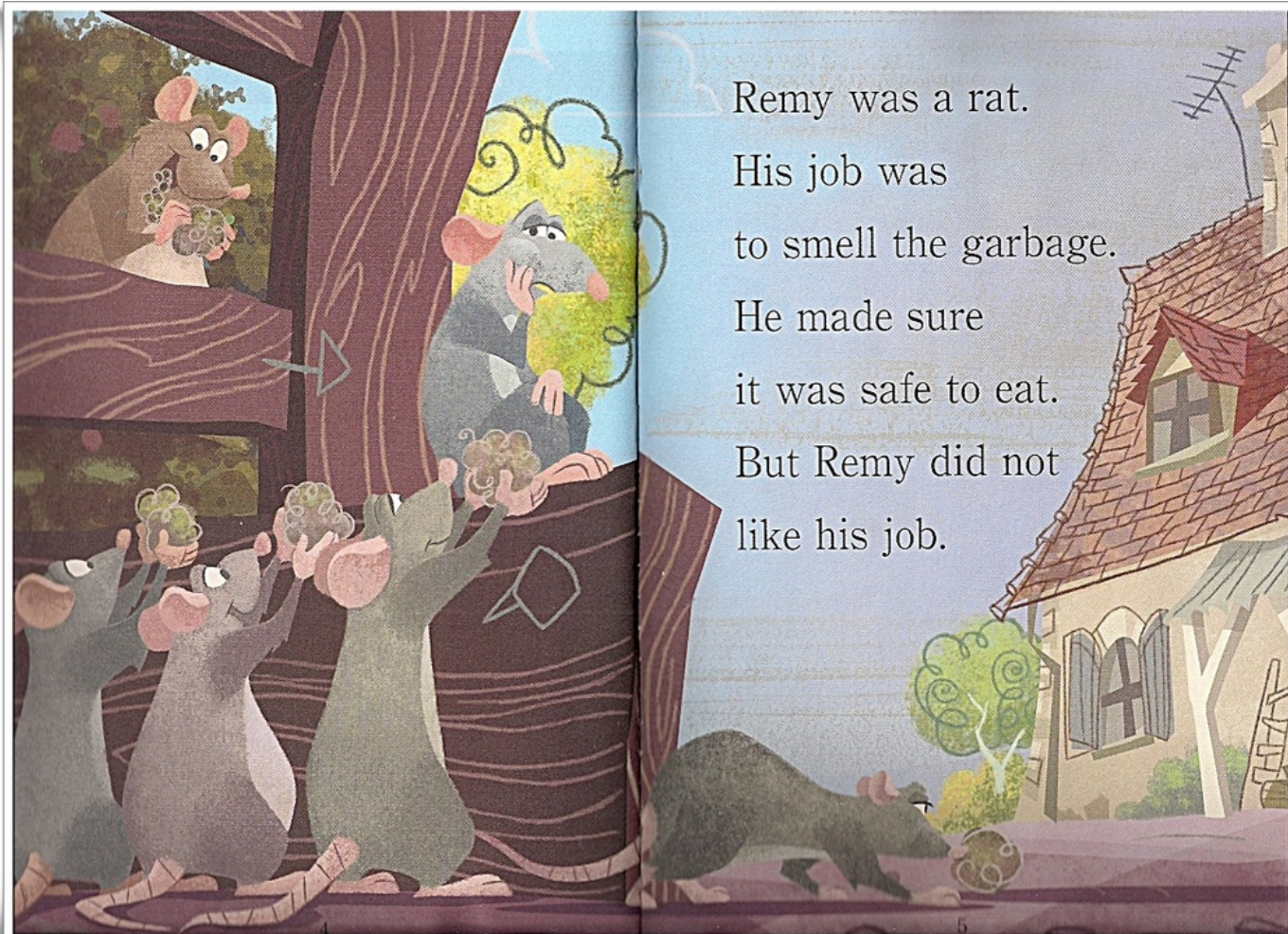

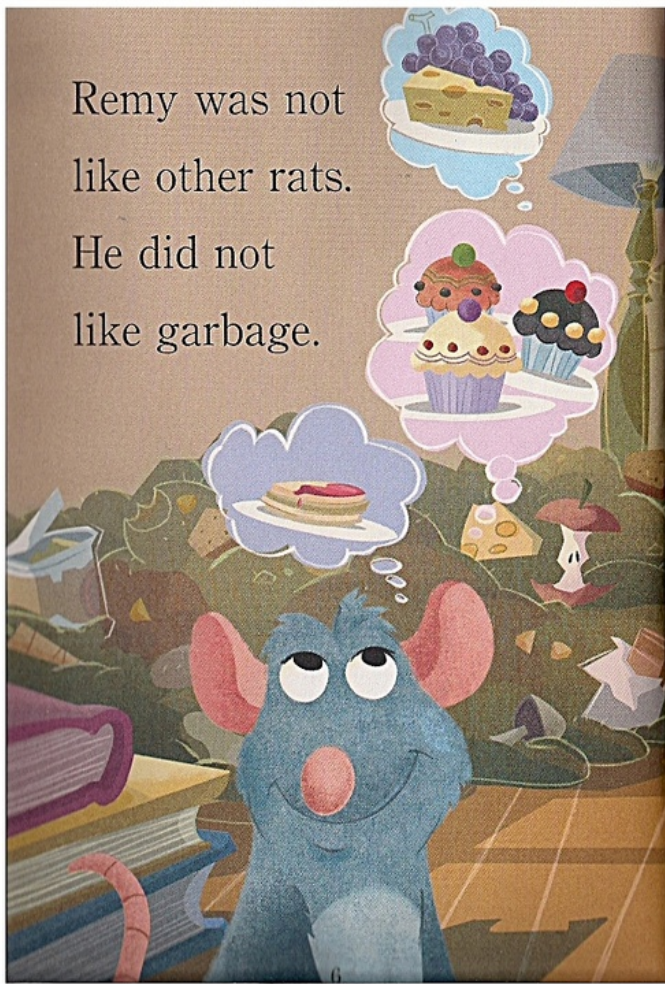

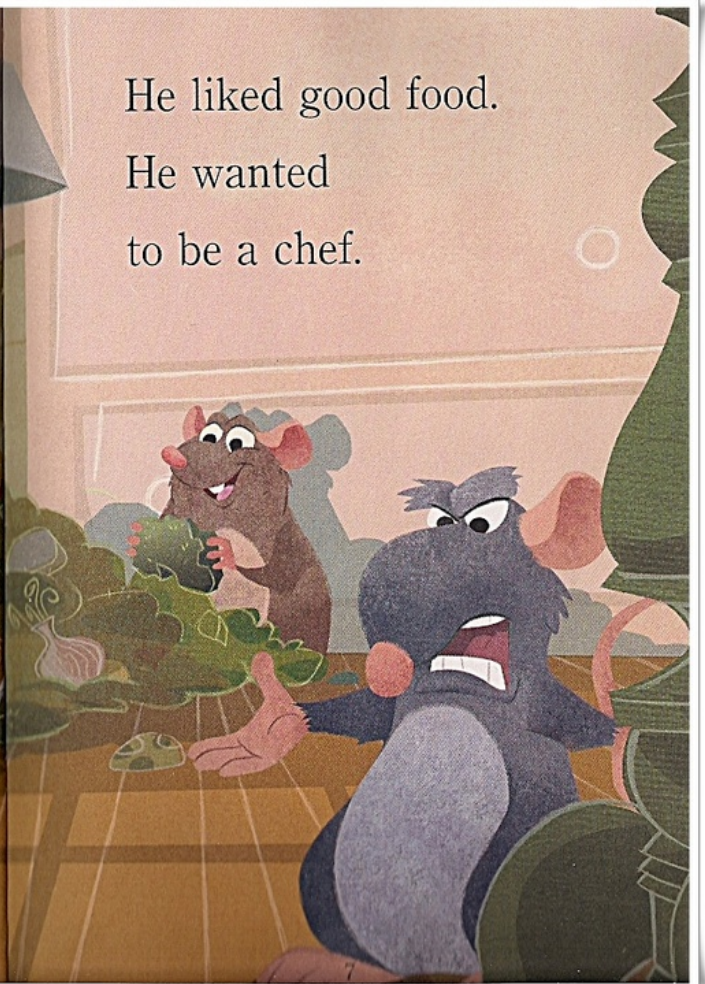

like garbage.



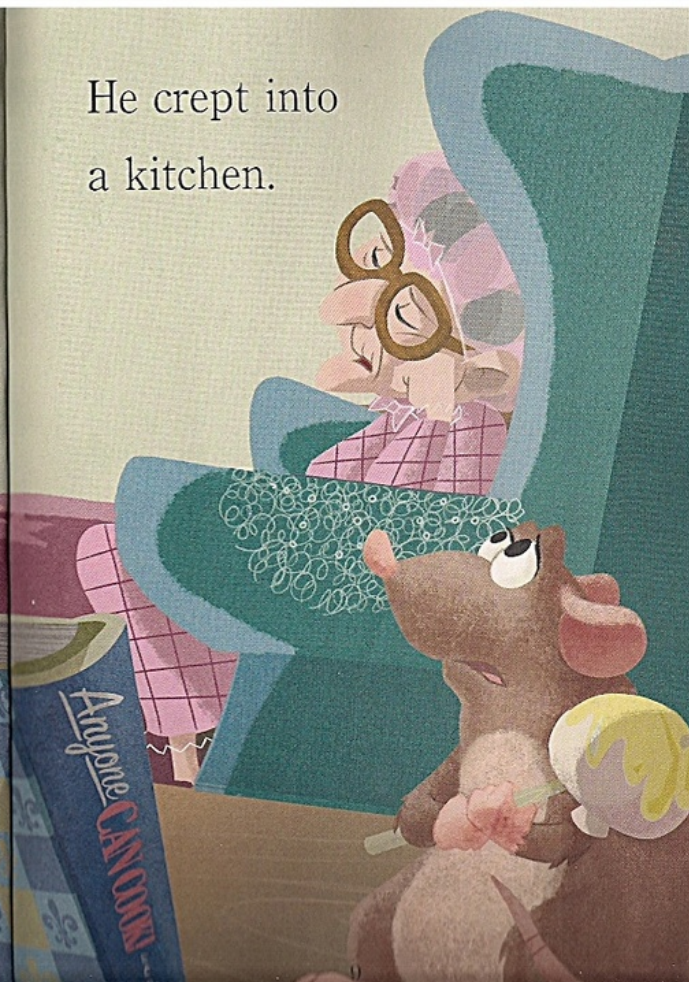
He liked good food.

a kitchen.

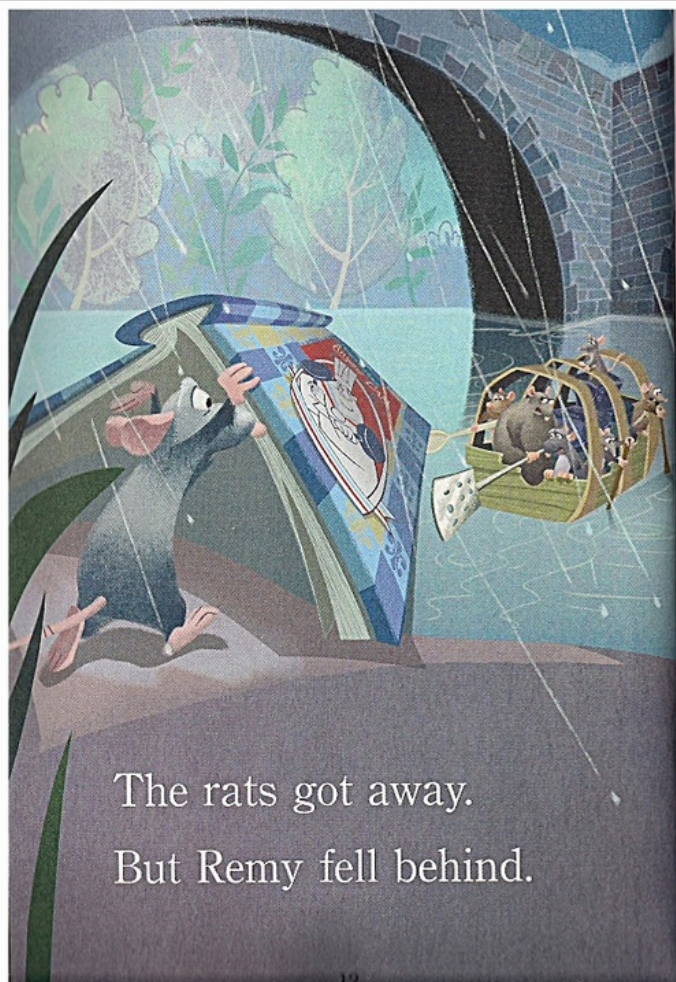


The old lady

a cookbook.



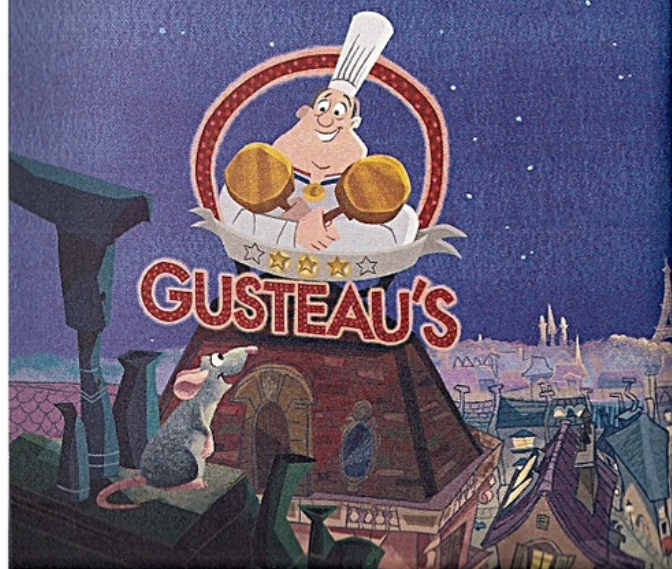


The rats got away.

the restaurant.

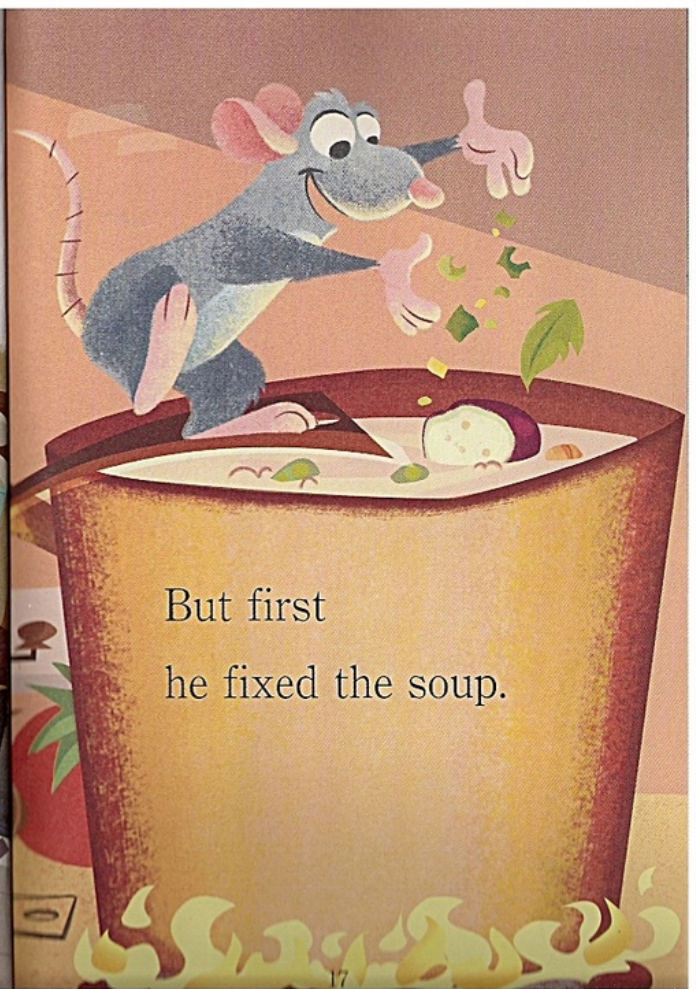
A boy named Linguini

cooked together.

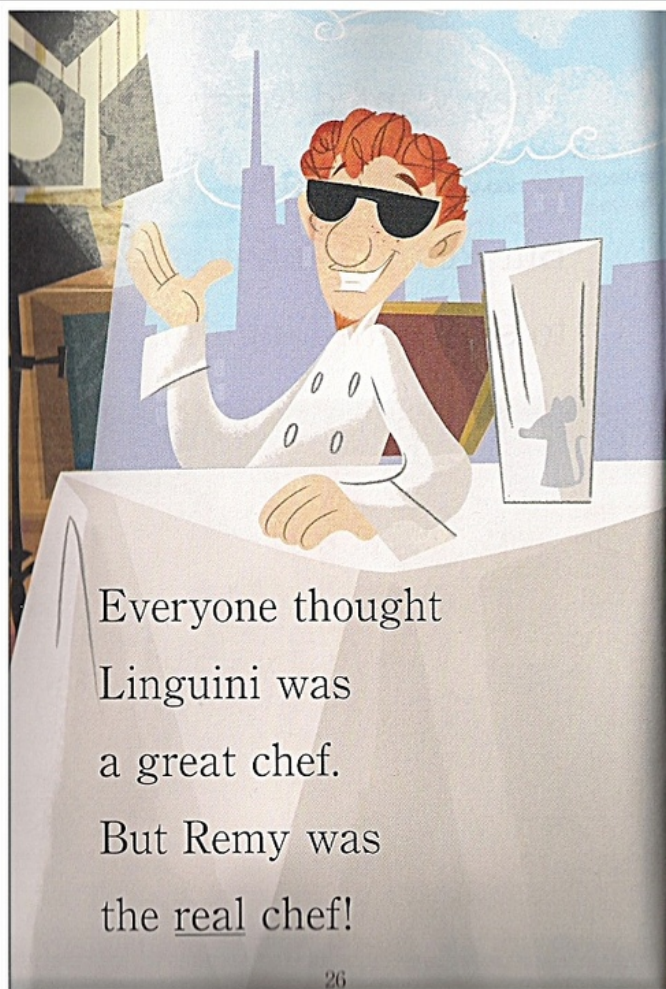
They were

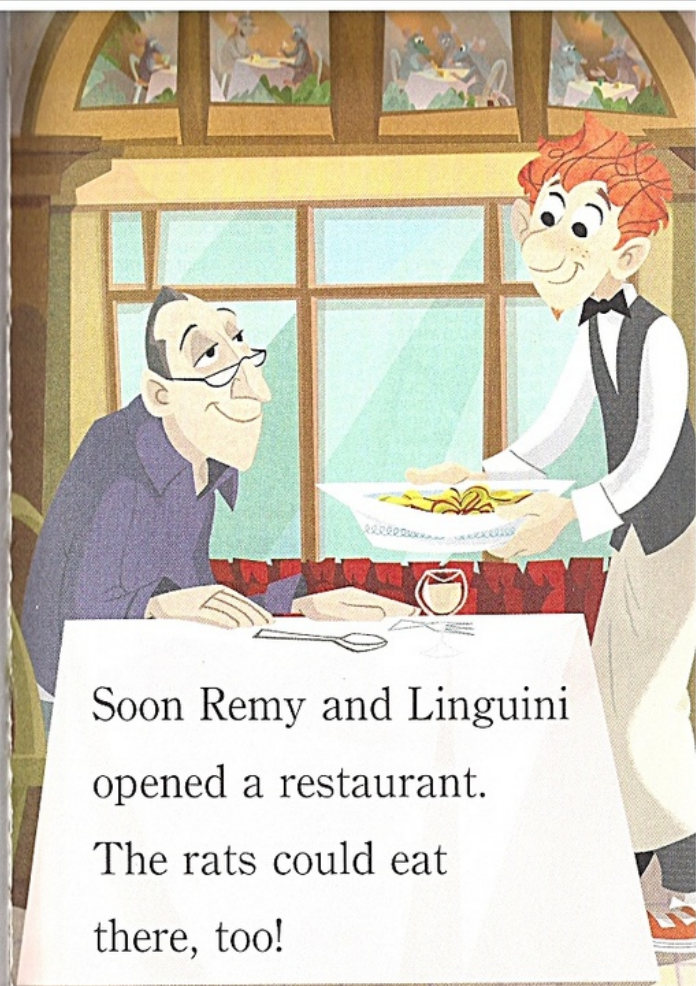
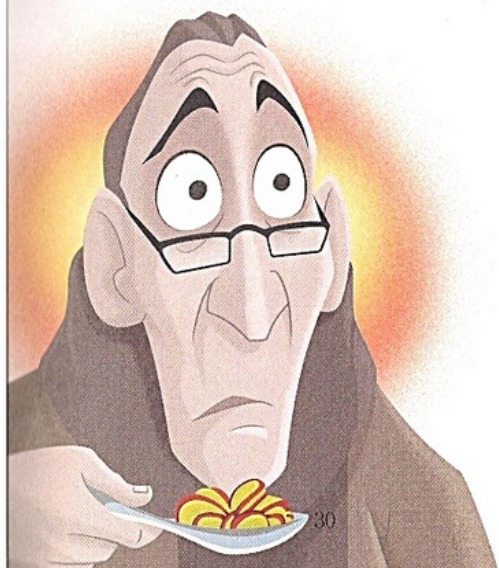
