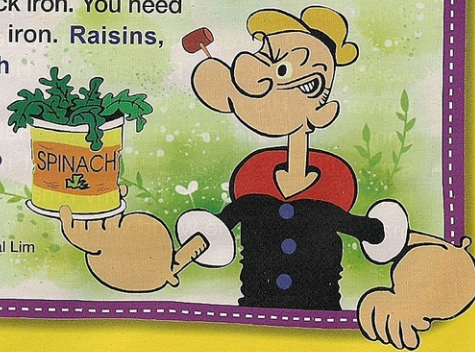




## FEEL DIZZY?

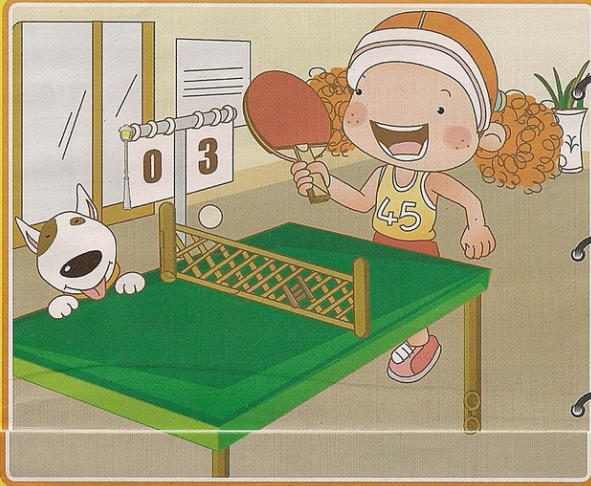

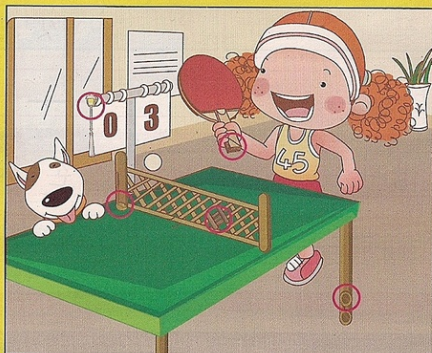

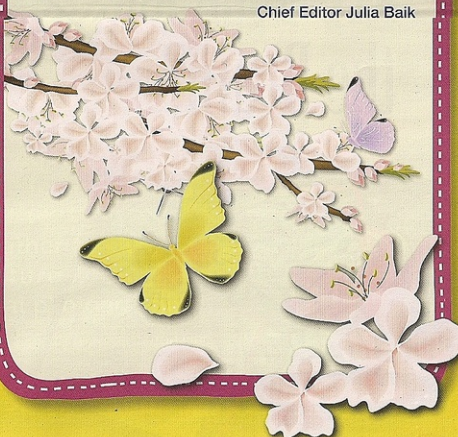
