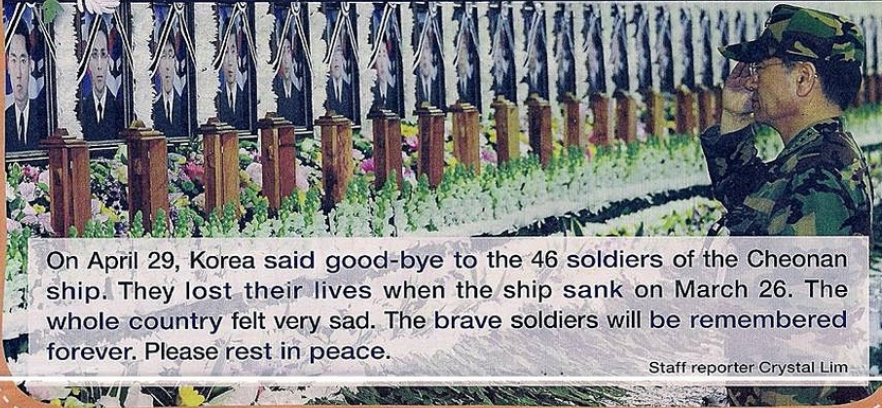

Understanding the Whales

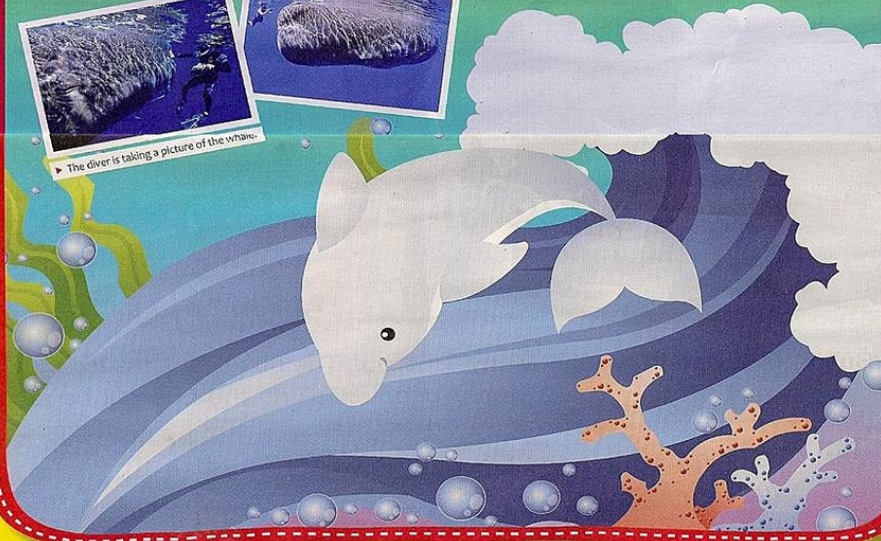

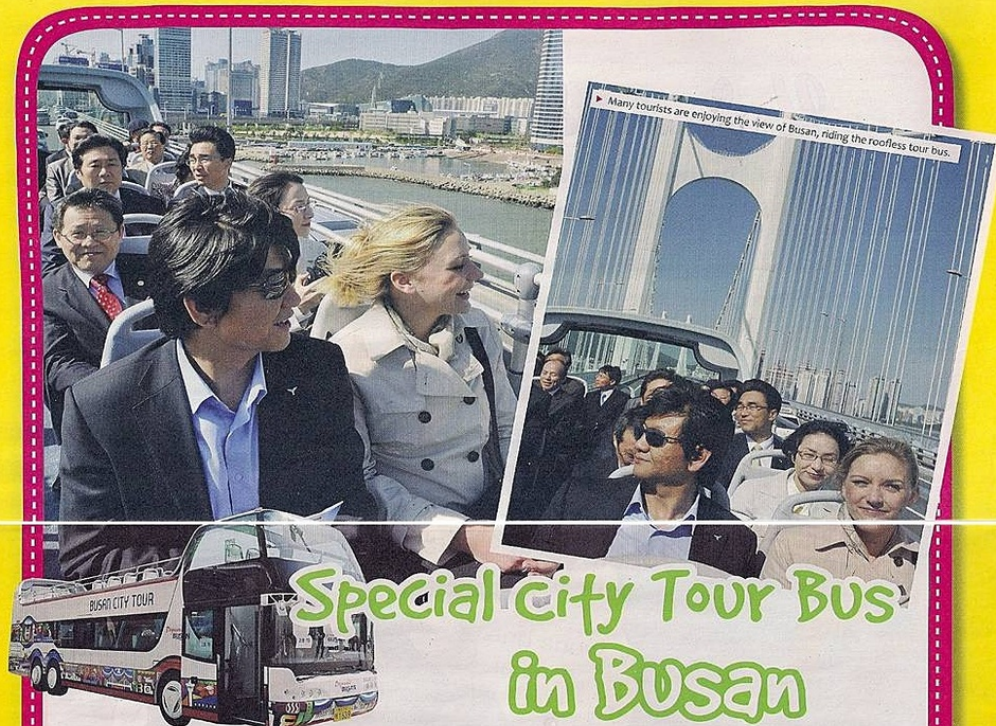
