### Yoo voted best comedian of the year



According to pollster Gallup Korea, Yoo Jae-suk was voted to be "the best comedian of year 2009" topping the list for the \*fifth consecutive year.

A total of 1,726 people over 13 were asked to name who they thought should be the best comedian of 2009. They could name one or two people. Of the respondents, 51.6 percent named Yoo, Gallup announced. Yoo has enjoyed the honor since 2005.

Currently, Yoo is hosting KBS "Happy Together," MBC "Infinite Challenge" (무현도전), "Come to Play" (놀러와) and SBS "Family Outing"(패웨리가 썼다)

Kang Ho-dong came in second, earning 43.5 percent, also \*preserving his place for five consecutive years.

Comedians Lee Soo-geun (11.3 percent), Shin Bongsun (7.8 percent), Park Myung-soo (4.4 percent), Park Mi-sun (4.3 percent), Ahn Young-mi (2.6 percent) and Park Ji-sun (2.3 percent) followed Kang.

Gallup said, "Yoo was popular with a wide range of groups, and Kang earned more votes with older participants of the poll."


Four female comedians entered the top 10 list, the largest number since the first survey was conducted in
