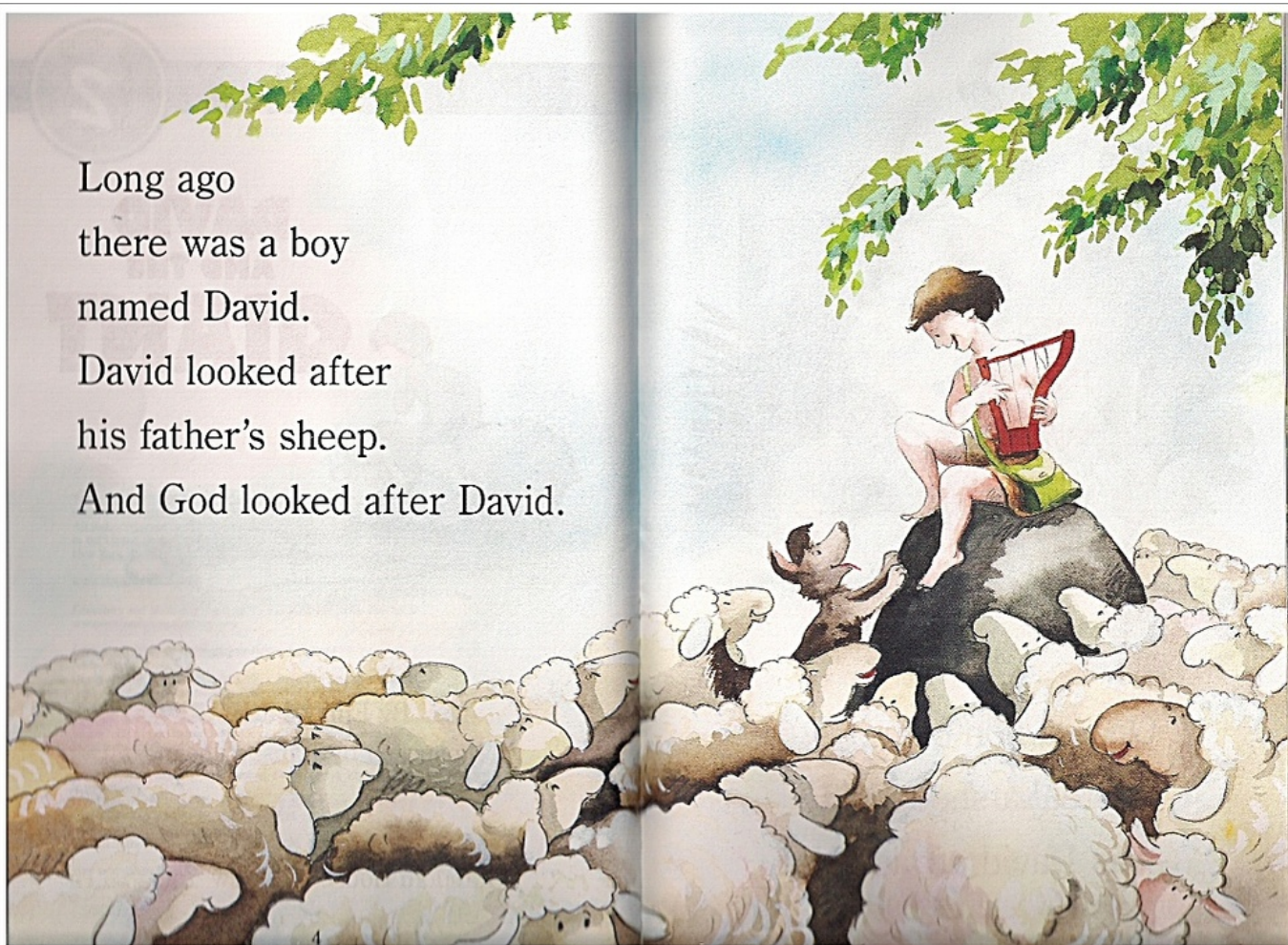

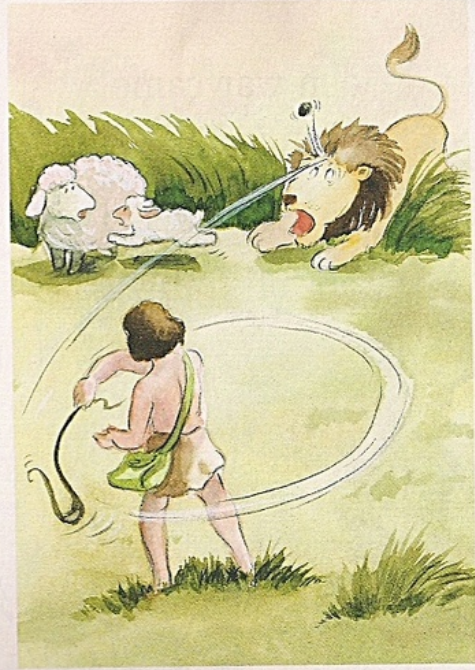
Long ago

He had to stay at home.

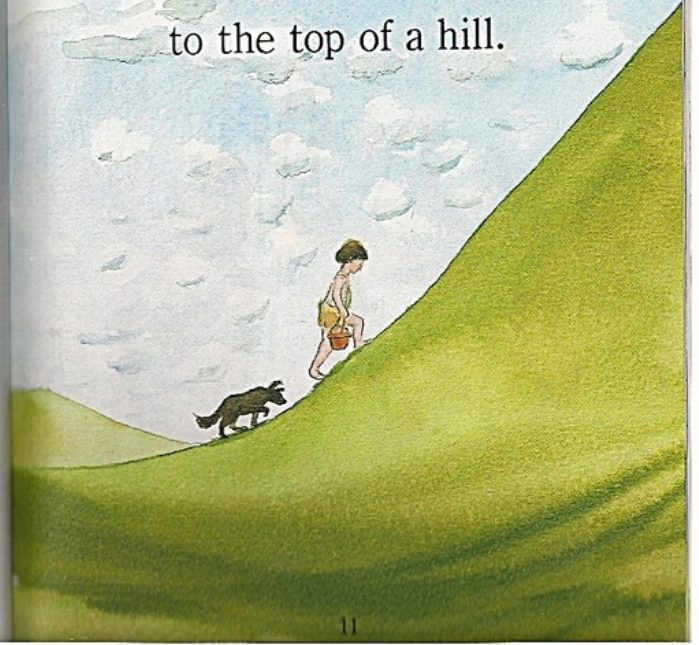

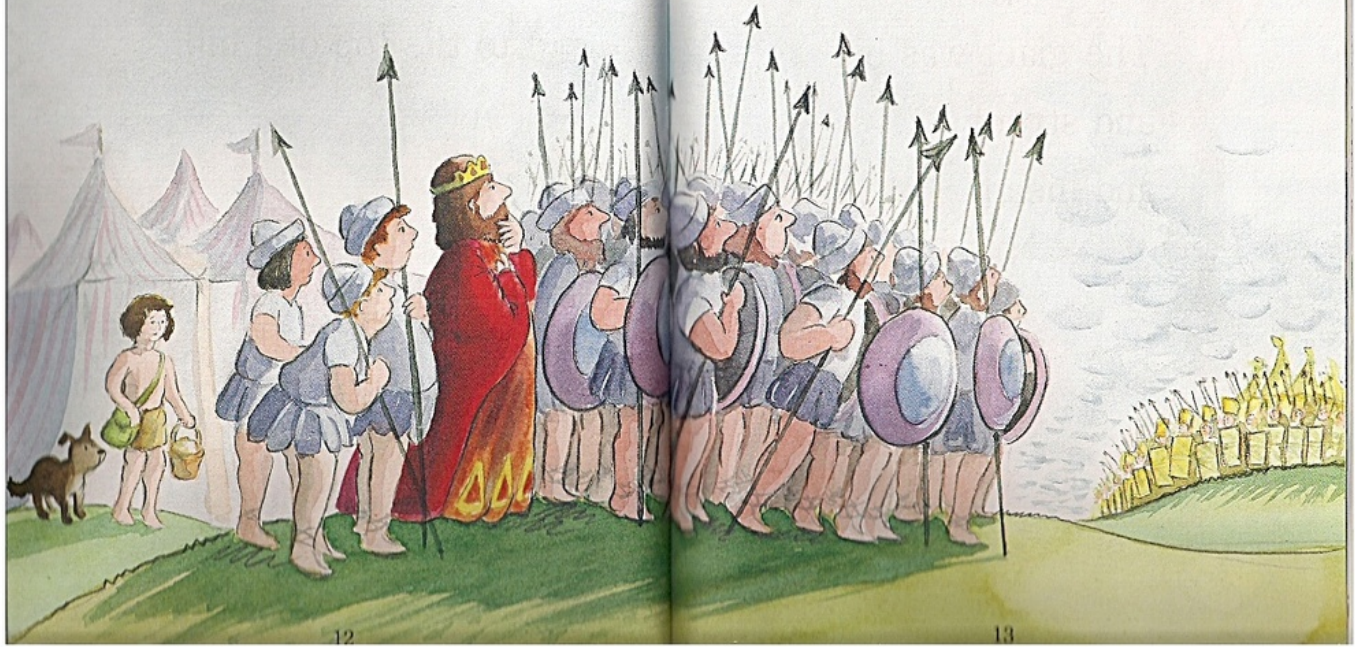
So David did.

to the top of a hill.



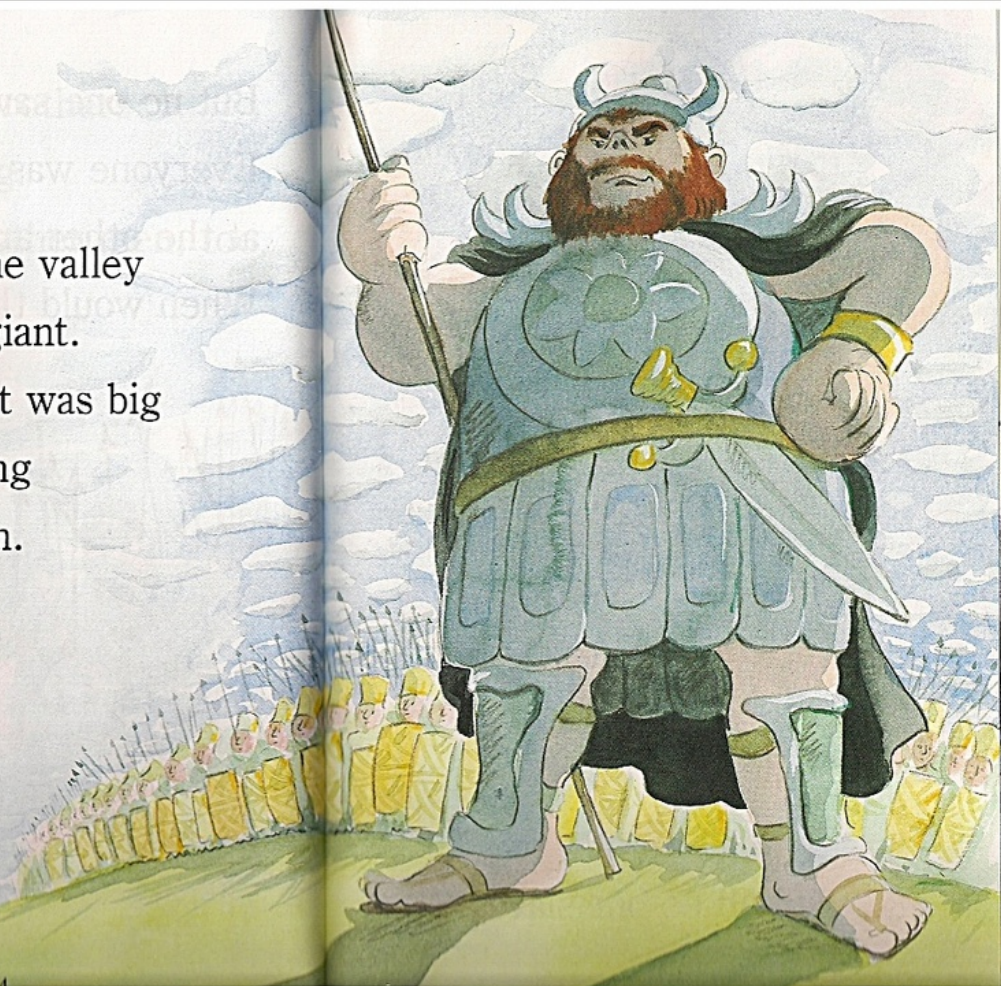


David saw his brothers.

and mean.

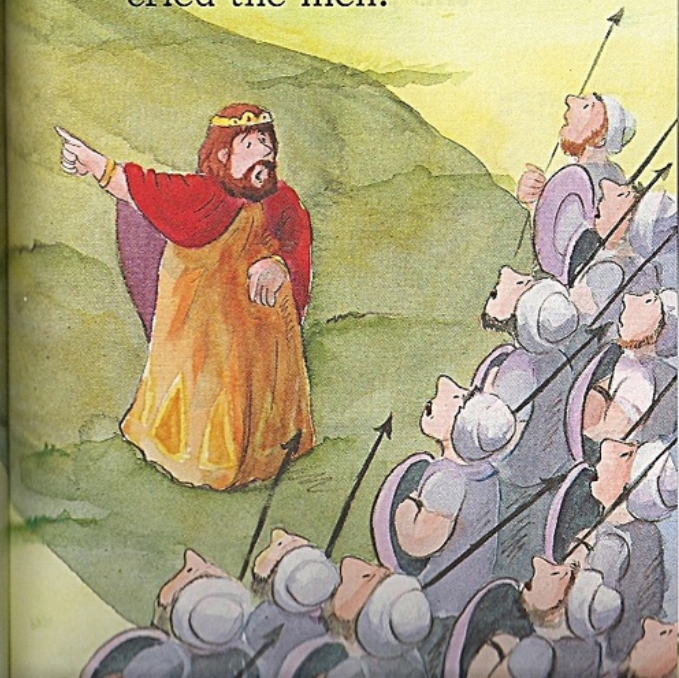




"I am Goliath.
