
4. I'm a Student, Too!






Let's Make a Paper Carnation for Parents' Day



On Parents' Day, we give carnations to our parents to thank them for their love. This year, why don't you make a special carnation by yourself? I'll show you how. Just prepare two sheets of colored papers, glue, and pinking shears. Then, follow the directions.

- 1. Fold the paper in half along the dotted line
- 2. Fold the paper in half again along the dotted line.
- 3. Unfold the inside and fold it again while pressing the inside to make it a square.
- 4. The result should look like this.
- 5. Turn it over and unfold the backside along the dotted line.
- 6. The folded structure should look like this.
- 7. Fold along the dotted lines like
- 8. Fold the right side again and then unfold it to have the lines like in this picture.

- 9. Cut the upper part with the pinking shears.
- 10. Now the flower is done!
- 11. To make a flower cup, prepare a green colored piece of paper and fold it in half to make a triangle shape. Then, fold it along the dotted lines.
- 12. The flower cup should look
- 13. Put the flower and the flower cup together with the glue.

Lastly, give the hand-made paper carnation to your parents and see their smiles!


