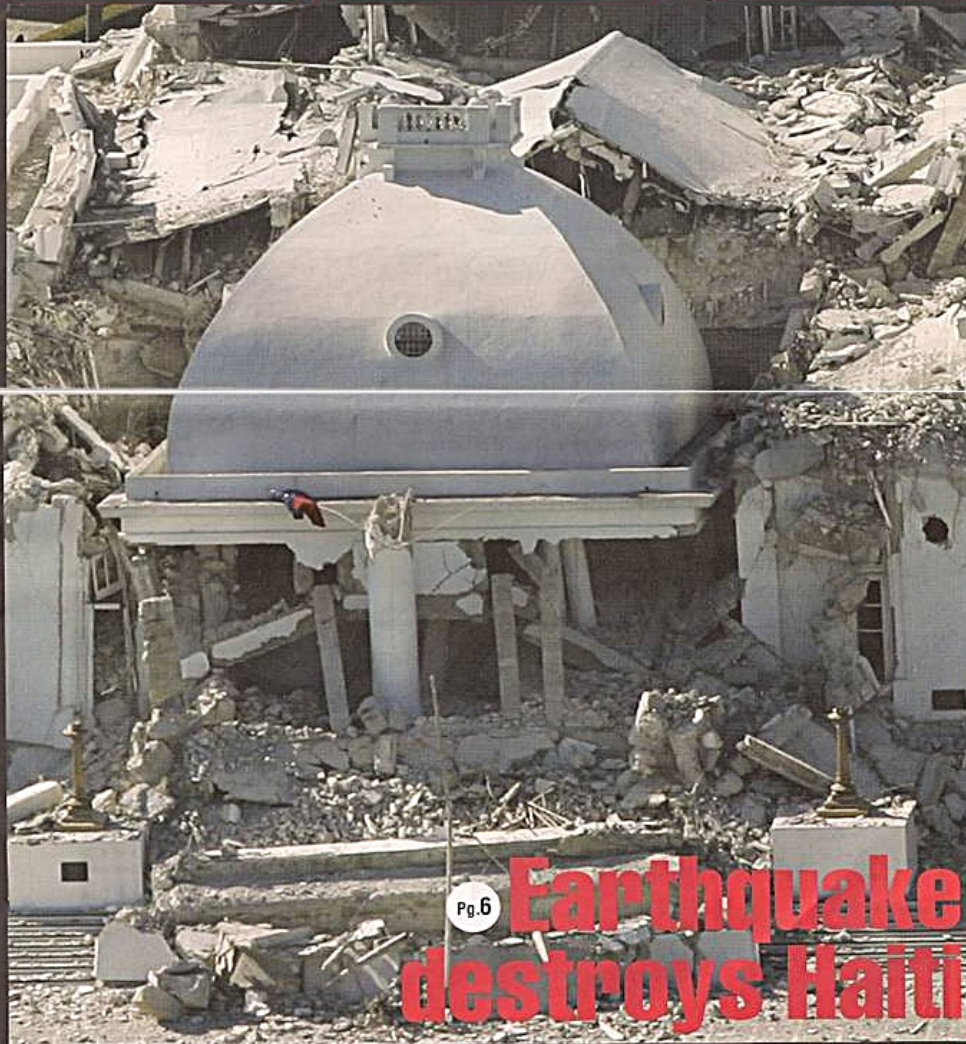

Hebrew Bible written earlier than thought

*Scholars have discovered an ancient Hebrew Bible. According to msnbc, the Bible is dated to the 10th century BC which was during the period of King David's dynasty.

"It indicates that the Kingdom of Israel already *existed in the 10th century BC and that at least some of the biblical texts were written hundreds of years before the dates presented in current research," said Gershon Galil, a professor of Biblical Studies at the University of Haifa in Israel, who *deciphered the ancient text.

Scholars believed that the Hebrew writing *originated in 6th century BC. Therefore they assumed that the first Bible was written in that period. ①

Korea's internet speed fastest in the world

Akamai Technologies, an international web traffic monitor, recently released last year's "third quarter's "State of the Internet" report. According to this report, Korea continues to have the world's fastest internet speed.

Korea's *average connection speed is 14.6 Mbps. This is nearly twice more faster than Japan which came in second on the list. Japan has an average speed of 7.9 Mbps followed by Hong Kong with 7.6 Mbps.

The United States was not included in the top 10 list. It was ranked 18th with an internet speed of 3.9 Mbps. ①

Government restricts 'junk food' advertisement

The government announced that it will restrict "junk food" television advertisements during certain time periods starting January. This is to prevent children from eating junk foods which may *harm children's health and cause them to be *obese.

Foods that are included in this category are hamburgers, pizzas, instant noodles, chocolate, candies and ice cream.

The cabinet approved this decision on Jan. 19. The advertisements will be restricted from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. everyday. ①

3-D TV: The new *buzzword



3-D TVs emerged as one of the hottest products during the world's biggest tech *tradeshaw in Las Vegas in the United States.

Major TV vendors such as Samsung, Sony, LG and Panasonic put up their 3-D TV line-ups. The show called CES 2010 drew lines of people and ended on Jan. 10 after a four-day run.

They held press conferences to "tout" their 3-D commitment. Panasonic, the sponsor of the smash hit "Avatar," brought the film producer Jon Landau to its press conference. Popular U.S. singer Taylor Swift performed live at Sony's press conference, which was shown in 3-D on the screen behind her.

*Optimism abounds as major TV makers are set to *roll out a wide array of 3-D TV models this year. They said that the time is *ripe for bringing 3-D entertainment to the living room.

But concerns remain over 3-D content and expensive costs of producing it. Many consumers also find it uncomfortable to wear 3-D glasses to watch TV at home.

"When you look at the results of films like 'Avatar,' you know consumers really want 3-D," IMAX CEO Richard Gelfond said during Sony's news conference.

In particular, the movie industry is making a big push for the technology in a bid to generate new cash as box office sales *decline.

TV vendors hope 3-D TVs will encourage consumers to upgrade their TVs, analysts said.

"Probably over the next five years it will very positively impact the market opportunity in this place."

Steve Koenig, CEA's director of industry *analysis, told The Korea Herald.

"In a nutshell 3-D is the next big thing in TV."

However, he said 3-D TVs face a number of challenges. "I also think any technology where you are requiring someone to wear something is inherently challenged... I don't wear glasses. But I saw Avatar 3-D. I found the glasses uncomfortable," he said.

Many CES attendees said they liked the 3-D experience on TV, but said they do not want to wear glasses to watch it at home.

"I think it's a good experience... But I don't think I would do it all day or everyday," Don Russeli, an attendee, told The Korea Herald after watching 3-D LED LCD TV displayed at the booth of Samsung

"I think for watching a movie, game and sporting event, I might do it. But I find the glasses thing to be a problem for everyday viewing."

"I think it's inconvenient. I think that if I am going to watch prime time TV, it's going to be hard to sit in front of the television with the glasses on for two hours," said Russeli, who works for an *advertising agency.

After watching a 3-D presentation at the Panasonic theater, AI Siniscal, an

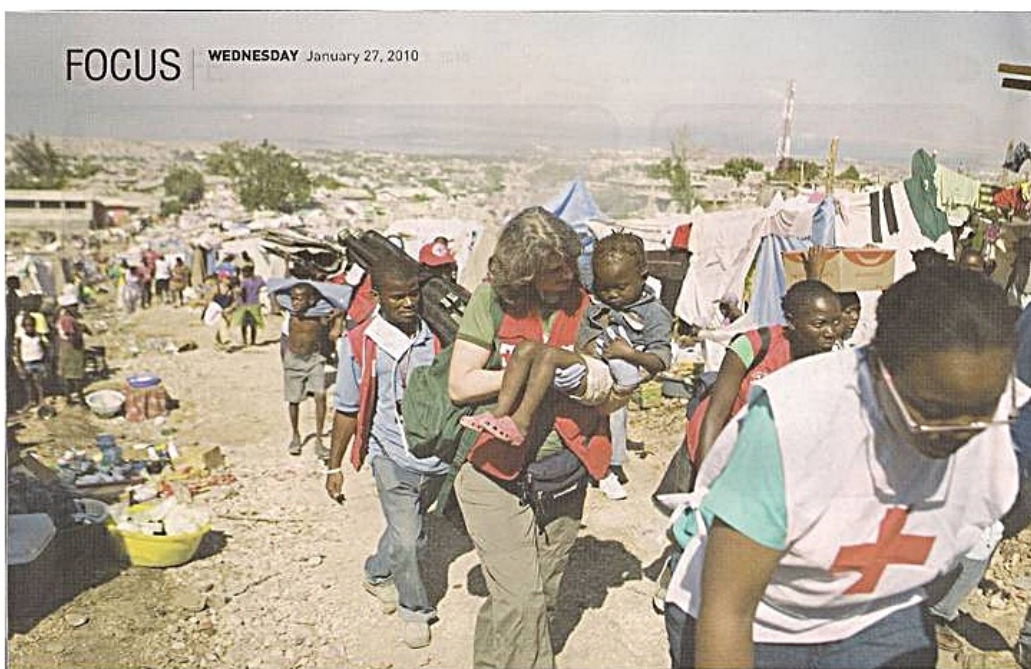
attendee, said. "I thought it was spectacular. It was interesting. I liked the depth a lot."

"I would like to buy a 3-D TV," the president of AI Entertainment Services, told The Korea Herald.

"The biggest hurdle is not technological issues, but whether or not broadcasters will be able to money from 3D business," an LG *executive told reporters.

Earthquake *destroys Haiti

After the *disaster, many survivors are struggling to get food and water. Some other *desperate survivors are *looting, making the country's *security condition unstable.

Haitian government officials said about 70,000 bodies have been found and buried in "mass graves. But relief workers express fear that the "death toll from may exceed 200,000.

pulling people from the *rubble a week after the powerful quake.

News reports said a quarter of a million people were injured and 1.5 million left homeless.

Aid groups estimated that about 200,000 families need immediate *shelter and non-food assistance.

Some 80 to 90 percent of buildings in the town of Leogane, just outside the capital Port-au-Prince, were destroyed.


Some 43 international search and rescue teams with 1,739 rescue workers and 161 dogs were at work. There is South Korea's 119 rescue team in the international search groups.

Thousands of U.S. troops are at work
to help *reconstruct the destroyed cities.

The huge quake rocked the Caribbean island, *toppling buildings and causing widespread damage and *panic.

The powerful quake was measured at 7.3 on the scale and struck 16 kilometers from the capital Port-au-Prince.

A tsunami alert was immediately
*issued for the Caribbean region after the
earthquake.

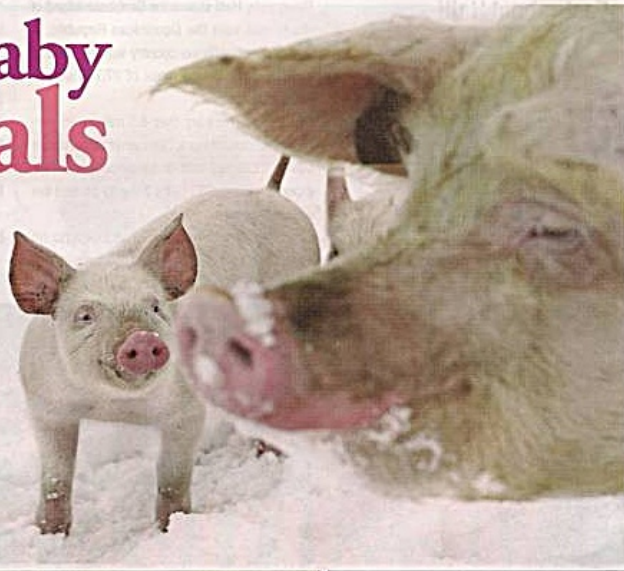
Just some minutes later, two *after-shocks measuring both 5.9 and 5.5 on the scale hit the region.

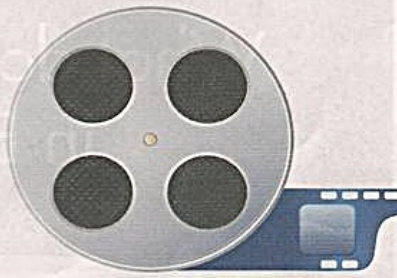

- 4 Female gorilla N'Yaounda holds her nine-day-old baby gorilla at Budapest Zoo on Jan. 14.

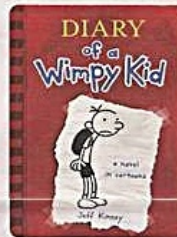

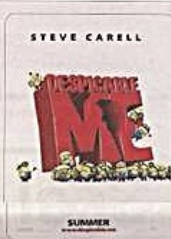

Sharapova to renew Nike contract for 78 billion won

Former Wimbledon champion Maria Sharapova *extended her sponsorship agreement with Nike Inc. by eight years for \$70 million (about 78 billion won), according to news reports.

The deal *takes effect in January and includes a line of dresses designed by the former top-ranked tennis player, Bloomberg reported.

Nike is the world's largest athletic-shoe maker, and has worked with the 22-year-old Russian player for 11 years.

The news agency reported that since winning Wimbledon in 2004 at the age of 17, Sharapova has become the world's best-paid female *athlete. She has also won the Australian and U.S. Opens. ①

Seol Ki-hyun signs with Pohang Steelers

Korean football star Seol Ki-hyun has signed a one-year contract with K-league Pohang Steelers. His contract with England's Fulham FC was *terminated, the team said on its website on Jan. 17.

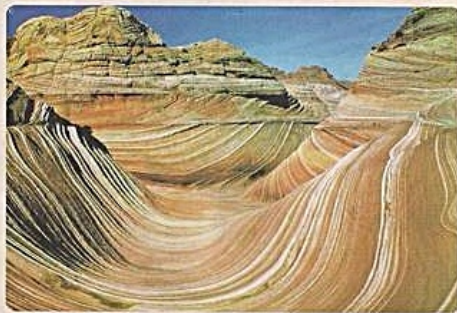
After showing an *outstanding performance in the 2002 FIFA World Cup co-hosted by Korea and Japan, 31-year old Seol moved to England in 2004, joining Championship club Wolverhampton Wanderers and then moving to Fulham in 2007 for a three-year contract.

"I have come back to the country in 10 years. I will repay fans' support by showing *advanced football skills *acquired from Europe," Seol told reporters. "I expect to contribute to the development of K-league through my experiences in the Premier League."

Seol hopes that his decision to re-join K-league will help improve his chance to be included in the 23-member South Korean World Cup *squad, his agency said. ①

Scientists had warned of major Haitian quake

As Haiti is recovering from the devastating 7.0 earthquake that hit the country on Jan. 12, it turns out that two years ago scientists had warned that a major earthquake was likely to hit the Caribbean nation.

In 2008 scientists warned Haitian officials that, according to their research, the Enriquillo fault could likely cause a major earthquake.

But even though the officials took the warning seriously, the time between the announcement and the recent earthquake was not enough time for much preparation to have been done. Even if Haiti were a developed country, it would have been hard to prepare for a major earthquake in just two years time.

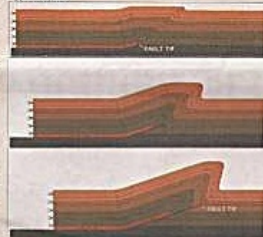
As of Jan. 20, the dead toll from the recent 7.0 earthquake is over 70,000.

In March 2008, a geological conference took place in the Dominican Republic. At the conference Paul Mann and Eric Calais reported that, based on their work, the Enriquillo fault was at a great risk of producing a major earthquake.

Mann's work was from research that he had done along the fault. He is a scientist at the University of Texas, in Austin, Texas.

Using global positioning system measurements, Calais was

able to identify rising stresses along the fault. He noticed that due to the increase in pressure in the fault, the Earth's crust was slowly deforming at the area where the fault crossed southern Haiti. Calais is a scientist at Purdue University, based in West Lafayette, Indiana.

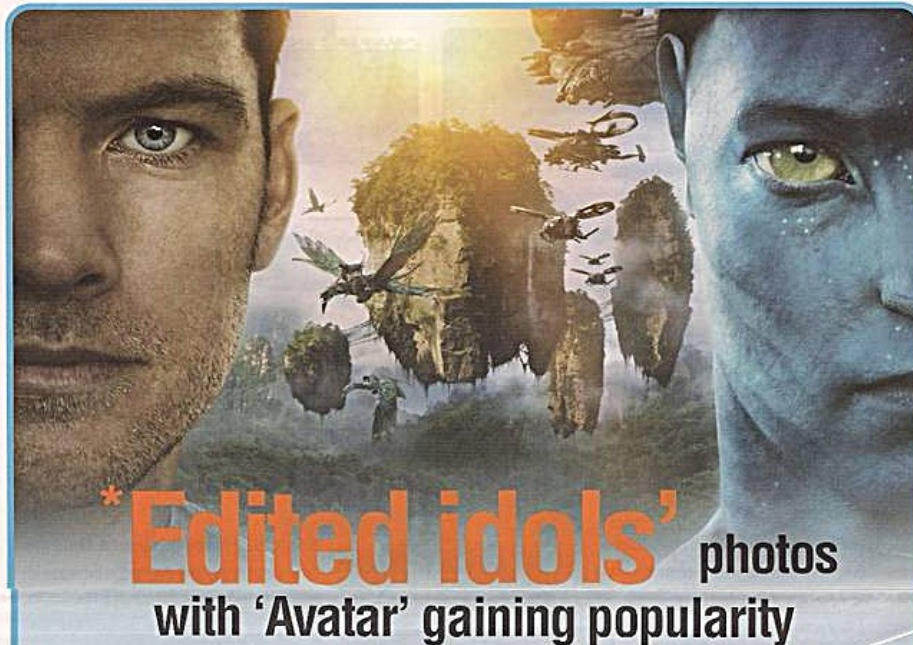
In addition to the findings by Mann and Calais, the last major earthquake to occur in the area was in 1770. So it was predicted that a major earthquake along the Enriquillo fault with a magnitude of 7.2 could likely occur.

Then in May 2008, Calais presented his findings at a number of meetings to Haitian officials, including the nation's prime minister. Calais advised that they needed to reinforce schools, hospitals and important government buildings to prepare for a major earthquake.

Unfortunately, Haiti does not have any seismic stations to monitor quake activity. Its neighbor, the Dominican Republic, does however have a small seismic network. The Dominican Republic and Haiti are both located on the island of Hispaniola.

The edited version of the "legendary band members" even express details in their faces as they look relaxed, "hilarious, or angry, drawing laughter from those who watch them.

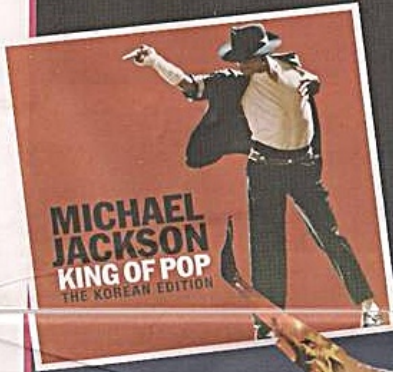

'Michael Jackson was murdered'



Michael Jackson's death has been officially ruled as murder, it was revealed on Jan. 10.

The British newspaper Daily Mail reported that the cause of death on the 50-year-old's death "certificate has been amended to "homicide" after months of speculation.

According to the document, the King of Pop died from "acute Propofol "intoxication" due to an "intravenous injection from another."

However, after further investigations, the certificate was amended and re-released in August by medical examiner Christopher Thomas. It now states the cause of death on June 25, 2009 as "homicide."

A source said that the Jackson family are "keeping faith with the police," adding: "We still feel that

there is more than one person responsible for Michael's tragic death."

The news comes after it emerged that the singer's doctor Conrad Murray is expected to be charged with "manslaughter."

Dr. Murray could be "prosecuted for "gross negligence" for his treatment of the pop star during his last hours, police sources said.

Murray, a "cardiologist, was with the star at his rented Los Angeles mansion in June and tried to revive him when he was found "unconscious."

A young Korean magician won first place at a magic competition in Japan and received about 13 million won in prize money. The competition was aired as a special feature on Asahi TV's "GOD HANDS 2."

On the show held on Jan. 8, Lim Jae-hoon, 20, performed several "feats of magic using 11 "doves.

The performances that most amazed the audience included turning flying handkerchiefs into doves and transforming green-colored toy doves to real doves.

Lim has been performing magic arts for eight years. He dropped out of high school and moved to Japan to learn magic from Yuji Yasuda. Reportedly, over 10 hours of daily practice and rehearsal was the "stepping stone for Lim to debut as a professional magician."

Korean companies join campaigns to help Haiti



Major conglomerates in Korea are participating in a global campaign to "raise donations to help the quake-hit Haiti.

Korea's No. 1 carmaker, Hyundai Motors, sent \$100,000 to Red Cross to support the devastated country.

"We have decided to join international society's "humanitarian efforts to help Haiti. We hope that the country will recover from the damage of the quake within a short period of time," said a Hyundai official.

Kolon Group said it will send some 150 sets of Kolon Sports-made tents to Haiti because it is urgently needed for families who were left homeless. These tents will be sent through Good Neighbors International, a "non-governmental organization.

Kolon Group first started its business as a nylon textile maker. But it has expanded the business and advanced to the fashion, leisure and construction industries.

Korea's largest conglomerate, Samsung Group, also announced that they will be joining in the move to help the Caribbean country. Samsung decided to donate \$1 million. According to a Samsung "spokesman, Samsung's "affiliates will also join in this donation drive.

An official at LG Group said LG Electronics have collected a total of 50 million won from its employees. "We would like to express sadness for the great loss that the Haitians are now experiencing," LG Group said in a statement.

"Apart from those conglomerates, ordinary citizens are also making moves to join the donation drive.

Various NGOs are currently waging campaigns to help Haitians. Official websites dealing with the donation campaign include Good Neighbors, Compassion, Save the Children, UNICEF, Cyworld Dotori Sponsorship and Naver Happy Bean Donation.

The civic organizations receive not only cash donations but also "relief supplies such as clothes, shoes, daily necessities, toys, etc. ①
