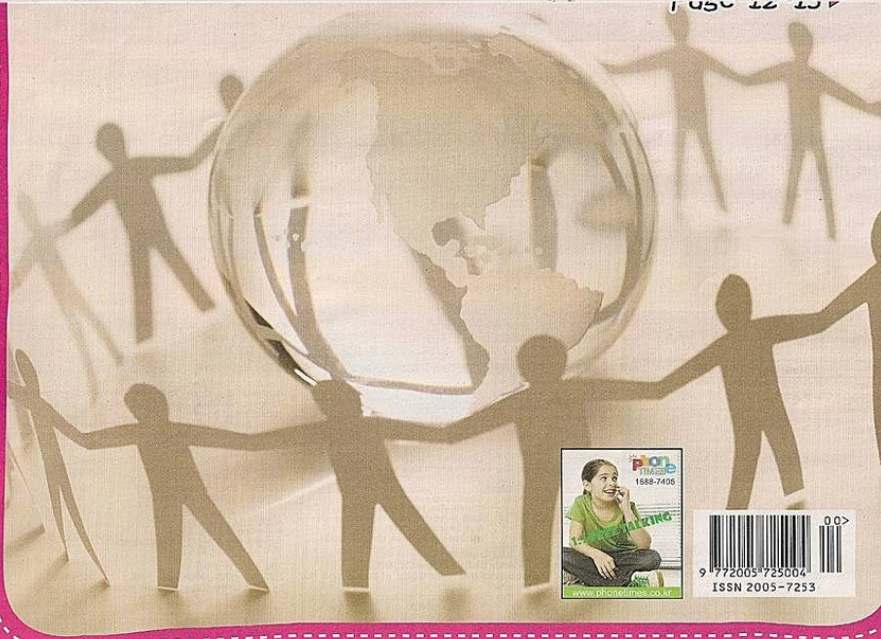

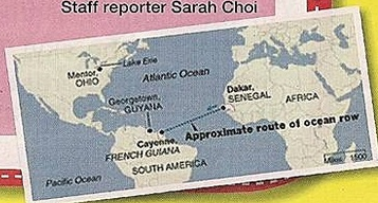


## Young American Lady Rows Across the Atlantic

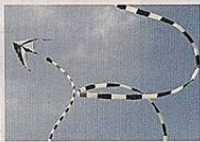

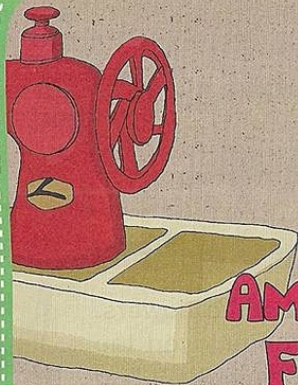

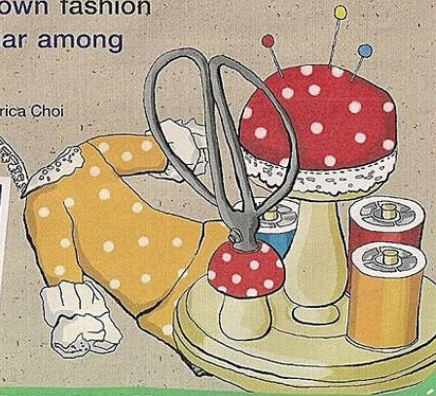




## AMERICA'S YOUNGEST FASHION DESIGNER
