
Let's Eat Oysters!

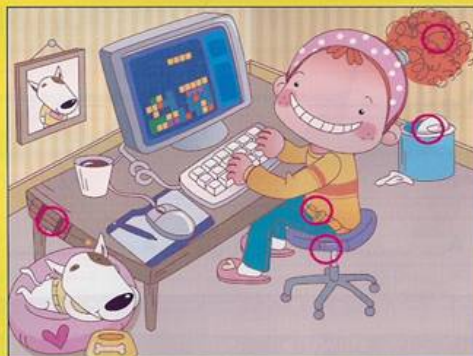


