Overseas Koreans Are Coming Back





In the 1970s and '80s, many Koreans moved to richer countries for various reasons. Some people emigrated to have better jobs and make more money. Many people also went overseas for better education and to improve the quality of their lives. Those who moved to other countries at that time are called, "first-generation emigrants." These days, many of those same emigrants are returning to Korea. The main reason is that they want to spend the remaining part of their lives where they were born. Also, a growing number of younger emigrants are coming back to Korea. Second and third-generation overseas Koreans are

looking for new opportunities back in the land of their parents. According to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade 외교통상부, 4,301 overseas Koreans returned to Korea in 2009. It is the highest number since 1997. The ministry said that since Korea hosted the 2002 World Cup, the number of people returning to Korea has steadily increased. "I guess the improved image of Korea and its economic growth has attracted emigrants back to Korea" a ministry official said.

Strawberry Crab Found in Taiwan



Recently, a new species of crab was discovered off the coast of southern Taiwan. It was found by a marine biologist named Ho Ping-ho. He is a professor at National Taiwan Ocean University. He said that he found the new crab species on January 5 that looks like a strawberry with small white dots on its red shell. A Taiwanese crab specialist named Wang Chia-hsiang confirmed Ho's finding. "The crab resembles the species

usually living in the areas around Hawaii, Polynesia, and Mauritius. But it has a unique clam-shaped shell about 2.5 centimeters wide, making it distinct," professor Ho said. Unfortunately, however, the strawberry crab died shortly after he caught it. Let's hope many more new species of crabs will be found!

Japanese Scientists Invent See-through Goldfish



In science class, you will learn about the organs of fish. In order to see the internal organs, your science teacher may even ask you to dissect a goldfish! You may enjoy the special

experiment, but many children find it gross. If you are one of them, here's good news for you. You can learn about the fish organs without having to cut one open!

Recently, Japanese scientists working together at Mie University and Nagoya University succeeded in developing transparent goldfish after 2 years of study. They decided to create the special fish to reduce the need for dissections in schools and laboratories. The see-through goldfish has transparent skin and scales. So you can see all its organs! "You can see a live heart and

other organs because the scales and skin are transparent," said Yutaka Tamaru, a researcher at Mie University. "You can also see a tiny brain above the goldfish's black eyes." The special goldfish is expected to live up to 20 years. It might grow as long as 25 centimeters and weigh more than 2 kilograms! This is much bigger than other fish used in experiments.

Foods That Are Harmful to Your Dog



World's Tallest Building Opens in DUBAI

On January 4, with fantastic fireworks, the tallest building in the world opened to the public in Dubai in the United Arab Emirates (UAE). It is called the Burj Khalifa. "Burj" means "tower" in Arabic. "Khalifa" is the name of the President of the UAE. So, how tall is the world's tallest building?

The Burj Khalifa is 828 meters tall and has 162 floors. It is 320 meters taller than Taipei 101, the previous record holder. The world's tallest building is twice as tall as the Empire State Building in New York City and its top can be seen from 100 kilometers away!

What's more amazing is the fact that the tallest building on Earth was built in cooperation with a Korean construction company! The construction began in February, 2005 by Samsung along with some other companies. It took about 5 years to build the tower. The tower's original name was Burj Dubai. But the name was changed to pay respects to the president.

Luxury hotels are located from the first floor to the 39th floor. From the 40th to the 108th floors are luxury apartments. Offices will occupy between the 109th to the 160th floors. An observatory is located on the 124th floor. Surprisingly, you can get to the observatory in less than a minute! This is because the Burj Khalifa also has the fastest elevators in the world and it takes less than 60 seconds to go up to the 124th floor. Isn't this amazing?

But, here is a question. How can they clean the windows of the building? The building has a total of 24,000 windows! According to an ABC news report, Australian workers will do the job. The workers will clean the windows by hanging on the walls. They will also use special window-cleaning machines.

If you have a chance to visit Dubai, make sure to visit the world's tallest building! -




As a matter of fact, it isn't his original name. His parents originally named him "George Garratt." But he thought his name was boring. So he decided to give himself a very special name and came up with

Go to Bed Early for Your Mental Health!




On January 2, researchers at Columbia University Medical Center in New York said that teens and children should get enough sleep for their mental health. According to them, children who don't get enough sleep are more likely to suffer from depression. "Teenagers should go to bed before 10 p.m. to stop them from developing depression," said James Gangwisch, who led the study.

The researchers found that teens and children who go to bed after midnight are more likely to suffer from depression than those who go to bed at 10 p.m. or earlier. They studied the sleeping habits of more than 15,000 students at American schools from age 12 to 17 for two years.

"We discovered in our new study that teens who reported sleeping 5 hours or less per night were 71 percent more likely to suffer from depression than children who reported getting 8 hours of sleep," Gangwisch explained. "A lack of sleep is also likely to make children more moody. They should get enough sleep for their mental health."

The researchers recommended teens to sleep at least 8 hours a day. "A good night's sleep can prevent depression in children and teens. Getting enough sleep can also cure depression." Their study was published in the January 1 issue of the journal "Sleep."
