





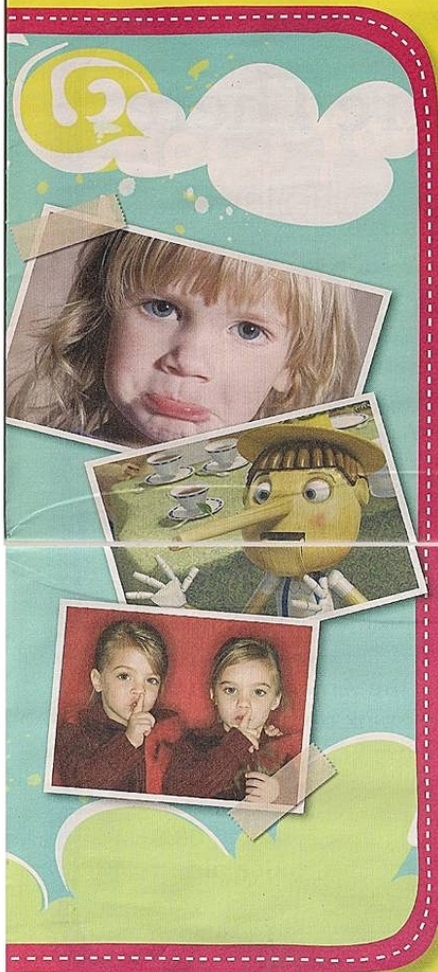
Bad Lies Are Never OK!




